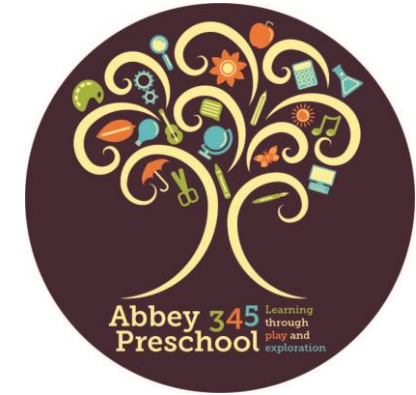
Your child can also join us for Breakfast Club at

Welcome to Preschool

A little bit about who we are

We are a committee run charity, operating a voluntary pre-school.

We are Ofsted regulated and operate the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum.

We have a staff team with a wide range of early years qualifications & experience.

Additionally, all staff have DBS clearance and have Paediatric First Aid training, Food Hygiene, Safeguarding & other mandatory training.

Whilst all staff are responsible for the welfare, safety and education of your child, we also operate a key person system. This means a specific staff member will be allocated to your child.

They will liaise with you in order to build your child's Learning Journey (an online record of your child's development during their time with us) and will be your contact at parent's evenings.



What will my child do in the session?



There is a wide range of opportunities and resources (both inside and out) to enable your child to develop their potential. All children are recognised as individuals and we aim to ensure that their interests and enthusiasms are used to promote their learning journey. During the school year we will be visiting a variety of topics and using them to explore our environment and enhancing our cultural capital. Many of these will be "hands on" i.e. growing and caring for plants, watching the development of living creatures or experimenting with sound, movement, science and creativity. Each week we also focus on a different colour, shape and number.

Our emphasis throughout, is learning through fun and promoting learning characteristics such as: playing & exploration, developing concentration and focus and becoming creative & critical thinkers. We encourage our children to gain self-motivation through their own active learning.

What do I need to remember?

- ☺ A supply of spare clothes: i.e. trousers/skirt, leggings, tops, pants and socks (ideally in a small rucksack).
- ☺ Spare nappies/pull-ups/baby wipes and nappy bags (in your child's rucksack)
- ☺ A pair of named wellies to keep at Preschool.
- ☺ Warm coats & hats (Winter)
- ☺ Sun hats and sun cream (Summer)

Please remember to name all items brought into Pre-School.
