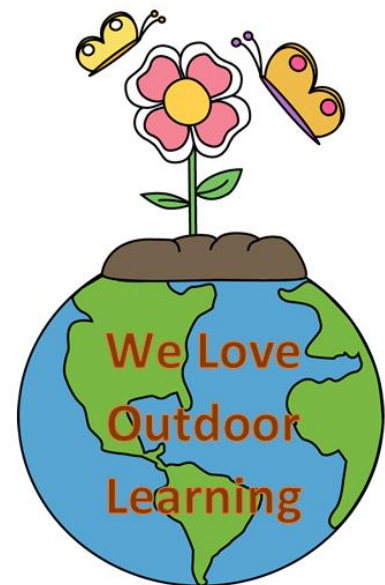
Newsletter - Term 2a (3 Jan to 9 Feb) 2017 / 2018
